



Hunter's Checklist

HUNTERS PROVIDE FOR THEMSELVES:

Camping Gear

- Block and Tackle
- Camp Fuel and Funnel (if you are bringing a portable gas stove or lantern)
- Cooler
- Cot
- Extra lantern mantels (if you choose to bring a lantern)
- Flashlight (with extra batteries and bulbs)
- Hatchet
- Lantern (only for camps where you won't have a generator)
- Mattress (Air or just the thermal pad)
- Pillow
- Sleeping Bag (good to -20 degrees)
- Sleeping Pad (Thermally insulated)
- Small Plastic Bags
- Stove Fuel/Propane
- Tarps (Plastic/Canvas/Nylon Types)
- Toilet (You will need to set up your own toilet)

Clothing

- Blaze Orange Vest
- Blue Jeans (wear in)
- Boots (1 pair, wear in)
- Camp Shoes (1 pair)
- Cotton Gloves (1 pair)
- Cotton Shirts (2, light weight)
- Cotton Socks (2 pair)
- Down Vest
- Down Coat/Jacket
- Electric Socks (1 pair)
- Handkerchiefs (2)
- Hat/Cap
- Leather Gloves (1 pair)
- Pants
- Rain Gear (poncho or jacket/pants)
- Turtleneck Shirt (wear in)

- Underwear (1 pair of long thermal or Under Armour)
- Underwear (6 changes)
- Wool Pants (light)
- Wool Shirts (2)
- Wool Socks (2 pair)
- Wool or Thermal Shirt

Hunting Gear

- Ammo (20 Rounds)
- Ammo Holster

Meals

You will be placed in a group with 2 or 3 other hunters and your group will be responsible for 1 dinner meal for the entire camp. You will be expected to prepare, cook, and clean up from the dinner.

You will provide for your own breakfasts, lunches and snacks.

Emergency Pack

- Aluminum Foil
- Butane Lighter

- Fire starter (0000 steel wool)
- First Aid kit
- Flares (firearm cartridge type)
- Flashlight (small)
- Gorp (mixed nuts, raisins, dried fruit & M&M's)
- Knives
- Maps
- Matches (safety)
- Mirror (small)
- Nails (10 penny)
- Pen (make sure it works!)
- Plastic Square (8' square for use as tarp/lean-to/poncho)
- Radios (Walkie Talkies type with extra batteries)
- Rope/Cord (parachute type)
- Sunglasses
- Snare Wire (braided #1)
- Space Blanket (Lightweight emergency type)
- Stroblight
- Surgical tubing (3' for use as a drinking tube, sling shot, belt, tourniquet)
- Survival Pamphlet
- Thermometer (small outdoor for your pack)
- Toilet Paper
- Whetstone or Crock Sticks

- Whistle (plastic, coaches type)
- Wire Saw
- Wool Gloves/Mittens (1 pair each)
- Wool Socks (1 pair for the emergency kit)

Never underestimate the weather or your circumstances and never overestimate your own abilities. The items in your survival pack can save your life. . . as long as you go prepared!

Tents

- o 2 GP Medium (16' x 32')
- o 3 GP Small (16' hex)
- o 1 Kitchen (16' x 20')
- o 1 Command Post (10' x 20')
- o (COFA will determine which of these tents will be necessary for each hunt)
- o Propane heaters for each tent
- o Electric lights for each tent
